Reservations/Payments

Reservations will be taken over the phone, at any of our offices, via e-mail (gyc@nebat.com) or through the mail on a first-come, first-serve basis. A minimum \$10.00 per person down payment is required for all one-day trips; all overnight tours require a minimum deposit of \$50.00 (trips involving airfare and theatre tickets may vary in down payment; see individual reservation forms). This down payment is due within 10 days of making your reservation. The balance is due at least 30 days prior to departure; please note each trip brochure for specific date. Payments received after the final payment due date indicated will incur an additional \$5.00 late fee. Reservations made after the final deadline date may have an additional vendor(s) charge added to the price of the tour.

Cancellation

One-Day Trip Policy: If you choose to cancel your trip after you have made your deposit but before the final due date, you may transfer the full down payment to a scheduled National Exchange Bank & Trust (NEBAT) GYC tour, or we will refund your down payment minus a 50% processing fee. After the final payment due date, a refund will be sent minus the full down payment and any charges levied by the suppliers if your seat is resold. If your seat is not resold, no refund is available.

Extended and Airline Trip Policy: Cancellation policies vary. Insurance may be required on some tours and is included in the price. For other tours, trip cancellation insurance is optional and may be purchased by traveler. Please inquire about each specific trip for details. If you must leave a tour, all miscellaneous expenses (such as transportation, hotels, etc.) are assumed by you. Passengers needing medical attention requiring hospital transportation cannot be guaranteed NEBAT escort accompaniment. Should a trip be delayed due to circumstances beyond NEBAT's control, the traveler will assume all individual costs related to the delay. If NEBAT should have to cancel a tour prior to departure, a full refund will be given to each traveler. National Exchange Bank & Trust reserves the right to change the routing, hotel and/or sightseeing services of any itinerary or tour outlined, should conditions warrant. Day 2 - Friday, April 17, 2009

Today we venture to **Maker's Mark Distillery**, producers of fine Kentucky

bourbon and the only operating distillery to be a National Historic Landmark. **Lunch** will be a special culinary treat at **Limestone Restaurant** - discover the Kentucky-famed hot brown! Next, we head to **The American Printing House for the Blind**, the world's largest nonprofit organization. Late afternoon finds us checking into the fabulous **Galt House**, our home for two nights. The Galt House is the only hotel located on the Ohio River and is the command center of **Thunder Over Louisville**. We will have time to freshen up before our evening at **Derby Dinner Playhouse**. This evening's performance is "**All Shook Up**," the hip swiveling, lip curling, hot new Broadway musical that will have you dancing in your chair!

Day 3 - Saturday, April 18, 2009

Our morning begins with **breakfast** at the historic **Churchill Downs**, home to the Kentucky Derby, followed with a guided **tour of the racetrack** and a visit to the **Kentucky Derby Museum**. Then on to **Glassworks**, dedicated to the art of glass, its magic, its mystery and its beauty. From there we enjoy lunch at **Lynn's Paradise Café**. Finally the time has arrived - the event we have been waiting for! We are back to the Galt House for all the **ACTION! NEBAT travelers** will enjoy a **private** viewing of one of the largest air shows in the country. **Snacks** and a **light supper** will be provided.
