A short ride will have us arriving in **Galena** at the Victorian country estate, the **Ryan Mansion**. You will meet the butler, maid and cook as they show you a spirited backstairs view of the upper crust. Enjoy **coffee, tea and special sweets** as you listen to secrets from the past.

Our home for the next two nights will be **The Irish Cottage Boutique Hotel**. Enjoy your room dressed in an Irish theme along with the Irish staff. The lit of Irish laughter and the sound of soft Celtic times will entice your senses. Enjoy a drink at the Frank O'Dowd's Irish Pub in the hotel before we enjoy an **Irish dinner**. The **tarot ladies** will showcase the intriguing and intuitive ancient method of fortune-telling this evening. After dinner, a colorful review of "**Remembering Old Galena**" offers a fascinating portrait of the town's history in an original musical production. Enjoy a **deluxe continental Irish breakfast** in the hotel's breakfast room before departing for the day. A marvelous dinner is planned at **Fried Green Tomatoes** including the icon appetizer "Fried Green Tomatoes." **Folk singer Jim Post** will present a one-man musical historical play about Mark Twain's life on the Mississippi at the **Galena Trolley Depot Theatre**.

Thursday, September 16

Enjoy the **Irish breakfast** before we depart from our cozy hotel. A stop at **Wooded Wonderland Country Store and Sawmill** will take you back in time where working hands crafted and molded the essentials of life. Behold age-old craftsmanship at its finest.
